About This Course

This course, designed to impart the required knowledge and skills in order to recognise the workplace health and safety risks and hazards inherent in working with crystalline silica containing products and to determine and plan for the implementation of safe systems of work aimed at reducing exposure to within mandatory exposure limits.

The course is offered by Just Careers Training (RTO #91413) trading as Licences 4 Work.


The Safe Work Australia Code of Practice defines "silica exposure prevention" as:

- Managing risks for airborne contaminants; and
- everyone has a duty of care when working with materials involving silica exposure.

The current legislative instruments and Codes of Practice do not require the holding of a licence as an outcome of this training.

Course Prerequisites & Entry Requirements

There are no pre-requisites or co-requisites for this competency unit.



This Course Is Recommended For:

- Building and constructions workers
- Jewellery industry workers,
- Do It yourself (DIY) enthusiasts
- Anyone where their health and well-being is at risk through exposure to crystalline silica dust.

There is no requirement that you have already completed other training or licencing prior to undertaking this course, or that you complete the training.

What is Covered in the Course?

Topics Covered Include:

- Identify crystalline silica hazards
- Determine legislative and safety standard requirements
- Apply risk control measures

Who Can Do This Course?

To participate in the Face to Face (F2F) course:

- You must be at least 14 years of age to do this course (you will need a guardian to sign off a permission and awareness slip if you are under 18 years old)
- You must present sufficient identification (between ID's you should have a Signature, Photo, Address and Date of Birth).

To participate in the Face to Screen (F2S) course;

- You must physically be located one hundred (100) kilometres from the nearest RTO approved to deliver Face to Face 10830NAT Course in Crystalline Silica Exposure Prevention.
- You must be at least 14 years of age to do this course (you will need a guardian to sign off a permission and awareness slip if you are under 18 years old).
- You must present sufficient identification (between ID's you should have a Signature, Photo, Address and Date of Birth).
- A secure and stable internet connection, computer, laptop or tablet and MS Teams to complete the course work. A mobile phone is not suitable.

How Long is the Course?

Face to Face

This course runs:

- Pre-course study of approximately 2 hours (self-paced)
- 1/2-day attendance (4 hours) at one of our training centres
- Post Training Study of approximately 1 hour
- Assessment

Face to Screen

This course runs:

- Pre-course study of approximately 2 hours (self-paced)
- 1/2-day attendance (4 hours) in our virtual classroom
- Post Training Study of approximately 1 hours
- Assessment

Assessments and Tests

Attaining your Statement of Attainment for this course involves attending your course, undertaking training, completing theory and practical activities and undertaking a final assessment. You will only be permitted to undertake final assessments if you feel you are ready, and your trainer/assessor allows you to undertake assessment (and this is based on your participation and completion of activities).

What do I need to bring?

- Your ID 1 legal photo ID is usually sufficient (i.e Drivers Licence / Proof of Age Card)
- Long pants, long sleeve shirt, closed shoes (preferably hard caps, but not compulsory)
- When attending Face to Face Classes, you will not be allowed to do the course in open shoes, skirts, or short sleeve shirts and singlet.
- When attending Face to Screen classes an appropriate standard of dress typical of in class attendance is required.
